Voting Options 2020!

Vote By Mail



All active registered voters will receive a ballot by mail by October 14. If you did not receive yours contact your County Clerk's office.

How do I use a "Vote by Mail" Ballot?

Fill out and return the ballot *as soon as you receive it*. There may be mail delays and you want to insure that your ballot is counted.

The ballot will come with two envelopes.

1. Insert your filled out ballot *into the envelope with the certificate attached*.
2. Sign the certificate but **DO NOT DETACH IT**.
3. Insert the envelope with the signed certificate containing your ballot into the envelope with the prepaid postage on it. You do **NOT** need a stamp.
4. Seal the outer envelope.
5. Deliver your sealed envelope in one of the four ways listed below.

4 Ways to Return your Mail-in Ballot



#1

Place in a secure ballot drop-box before 8:00 PM on November 3. There will be at least 10 drop-boxes in each NJ county (see list below).

#2

Put into U.S. Mail by dropping in a mailbox or bringing to a post office. Mail by October 20, 2020 or earlier to ensure arriving in time for election day.



#3

Bring to your polling location on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

#4

Deliver to your county Board of Elections any business day through



November 3. You will need to present personal identification.

How do I find out if my ballot was received?

- You may check on the status of your ballot by calling your County Board of Elections. You can find the number here:

You will need your Voter ID to use the NJ Voter Information System. Your Voter ID can be found on your Vote by Mail ballot

Ballot Drop Box Locations



Morris County

These boxes will be emptied daily by the County Elections Board and are an alternative to going to the Post Office. These boxes look like mailboxes, but they are not the “blue” of a USPS box.

1. Morris County Administration and Records building. 10 Court St. Morristown.
2. Chester Township Municipal Building – 1 Parker Rd. Parking lot by Clothing Drop Box
3. Denville Municipal Building – 1 St. Mary’s Place – outside Main Entrance.
4. Jefferson Municipal Building – 1033 Weldon Rd. Oak Ridge – outside main entrance.
5. Kinnelon Borough Town Hall – 130 Kinnelon Rd. –

parking lot – back entrance.

6. Long Hill Town Hall – 915 Valley Rd. – Gillette – side entrance

7. Madison – 62 Kings Rd. – behind Police Station – Commuter lot 3

8. Mendham Boro Police Dept. – 3 Cold Hill Rd South – outside front entrance

9. Montville Municipal Building – 195 Changebridge Rd.- in front of Municipal building

Mt. Olive Municipal Building – 204 Flanders/Drakestown Rd. Budd Lake parking lot entrance to municipal offices.

11. Parsippany Municipal Building – 1001 Parsippany Blvd. – outside main entrance, facing Rt. 287

12. Randolph Municipal Building – 502 Millbrook Ave. – outside main entrance.

13. Rockaway Twp. Municipal Building – 65 Mt. Hope Rd. – outside police department.

14. Roxbury Twp. Town Hall – 1715 Rt. 40 Ledgewood – outside main entrance.

15. Wharton Municipal building – 10 Robert St. – Wharton – outside main entrance.
